- development and implementation of a team training program/schedule along with personalized training plans for our Midget and Youth Racers
- design and execution of team training sessions (weekday evenings and weekends)
- active recruitment of new participants and development of racing programming for this age group.
- conducting safe, fun, and developmentally appropriate practices for T2T and/or L2C programs with the support of volunteer coaches and parents
