

Highlands Trailblazers hosting Cross Country Canada Level 2 Officials Course.

November 18-19, 2017

Level 2 Competition Officials Training is targeted at those who have had 2 or 3 assignments in different roles in previous ski seasons and are ready to step up to a "Chief" role. Ideally they should be Level 1 Certified. The Level 2 Course will enable the participant to:

- Understand officiating requirements for all formats of Cross Country Ski races
- Understand key regulations
- Supervise and mentor line officials to start, control and record races
- Locate information in Officials Manual and Competition Regulations
- Prepare Courses and Stadiums to meet needs of race formats
- Contribute to the Planning of races

The course involves some pre-seminar study and a short quiz.

The seminar takes place over 2 days (08:30 – 16:30) at Highlands Nordic.

The presentation material has been updated over the past few months and includes exciting video segments.

Exercises involve all participants in accurate simulations of race situations (probably without snow!).

Trailblazer members may participate at no cost. Members of other clubs will pay \$100.
