Preamble: Cross Country Ski Ontario is committed to support Ontario athletes who are selected to represent Canada at international races. We value excellence and reward excellence through the following International support guidelines.

Eligibility:

Athletes must meet the following minimum eligibility criteria:

- hold a valid Nordiq Canada (ON) & FIS/IPC racing license for the current competition year
- be a member of an Ontario club;
- be a Canadian citizen or have Permanent Resident status

Financial Support:

Cross Country Ski Ontario will provide the following as financial support for international competition and is subject to approval on an annual basis by XCSO Board of Directors.
