The start list will be posted on the <u>Zone4 Event page</u> on Saturday February 11th by 12:00PM.

Sanction

The Corkstown Classic is part of the NCD (National Capital District) race series. NCD points will be awarded as follows: Points are awarded on the basis of 15 points for first place, 13 for second place and 11 for third place, finishers from fourth place to twelfth place will receive one less point each (10,9,8,etc), all finishers after twelfth place receive 1 point each.

Competition Rules for Classic Technique

Nordiq Canada rules apply. Please review and abide by rules for classic technique races.

Poles must be no longer than 83% of the skiers height for classical events.

Where there are one or more set tracks, repeatedly changing or stepping in and out of tracks is not allowed.

Single and double-skating is not allowed.

Eligibility

Anyone may participate in this race. All U14+ racers must either possess a Nordiq Canada race license, a SFQ license (Québec) or purchase an Nordiq Canada Supporting Day Member License (SDML) during registration on Zone4.

Race Distances

Distances raced will be determined by racer's age category as follows:

Age	Distance
U8 & U10 Male and Female	1.5 km
U12 & U14 Male and Female	3.5 km
U16 & Older Male & Female	7 km (2x3.5km)
Para-nordic	Upon request. Please contact the organizers at knskiclub@gmail.com or racing@kanatanordic.ca

Registration Fees

Payable during registration on Zone4.

U8 to U10 - 1.5 km : \$15 (transaction fees extra)
U12 to U14 - 3.5 km : \$20 (transaction fees extra)
U16 & Older - 7 k : \$25 (transaction fees extra)

Para-nordic: dependent upon distance

Waxing Protocol

This race is a no-fluoro event. Only Non-Fluoro (NF) glide waxes are permitted to be used. Race participants are prohibited from using High-fluoro (HF), medium-fluoro (MF) or low-fluoro glide waxes, including HF or MF powders, pucks, blocks and liquids. This includes the use of cold weather powder additives & hardeners.

It is the responsibility of the athletes, coaches and parents to adhere to this guideline.

Waxing Area

While no indoor waxing facilities are available onsite, there will be a designated area where teams may set up their own tent and/or waxing tables.

On-Site Power

There is no onsite power for ski preparation.

Timing and Results

Timing will be carried out by Sportstats. Participants will wear a timing chip. Results will be available soon after each race is complete, both online and posted to our notice board.

Bib Pick Up

Bib pick-up will take place outside of the Race Office (trailer), located near the parking lot and stadium. Bib pick up will start at 7:30AM on race day.

- *For clubs with over 20 racers, bibs will be organized and grouped in bags and handed out to coaches/coordinators responsible for specific age groups, i.e. U14 male, U12 female etc..
- **Bibs must be returned upon crossing the finish line. There will be volunteers to assist with bib and timing chip removal in the finish area. Failure to return a bib will result in a \$50 charge to the club whose athlete did not return it.

Timing Chips

Wearable timing chips will be distributed to athletes upon entry to the Stadium immediately prior to your start time. Failure to return your chip at the end of the race will result in a \$50 lost chip fee.

For U8 to U16 categories, the first three finishers of each year of birth (YOB) for both males and females.

For U18, U20 and Senior categories, the first three finishers for both male and female.

Awards presentations will be held at the end of the 7km races, at the end of the 3.5km races and at the end of the 1.5km races.

Parking for race participants is available onsite at 401 Corkstown Road. Please be considerate of others and park in a manner to maximize parking space for others.
